Time Zone & Climate

Serbia is in the Central European Time zone (GMT+1) and switches to daylight saving time (GMT+2) from the last week of March until the last week of October. The climate of Kopaonik is predominantly mountain and sub-alpine, shaped by its high altitude and dense forest coverage. Summers are mild and pleasant, with moderate temperatures and cool nights, while winters are long, cold, and snowy, with a stable snow cover lasting well into spring.

Taxi price: about RSD 2500 (EUR 20)

Approximate travel time: 15–20 minutes

Important: At the airport, passengers can obtain a **taxi voucher with a fixed fare** for travel to the city center. This ensures a predefined price and helps avoid overcharging.

Currency

The official currency in Serbia is the Serbian dinar, abbreviated RSD.
Money can be exchanged in all banks and post offices, as well as in the authorized exchange offices.
The exchange rate for 1 EUR is around RSD 117.5.
